Massachusetts State Police Crime Lab Chemist, Bob Pino collected all of the evidence at the crime scene and wrote a report on his findings.

For items # 85, 86, 91, and 94 he reported that no items were found in the envelope. What happened to the items?

Pino listed 59 items had the presence of blood on them (page 17). Mary Kate McGilvray only reported to test 21 of those items.

Several years after this case, Pino was fired from the Director's position at the State Police Crime Lab for improper reporting methods in other cases. WILLIAM F. WELD

Several small blood stains were observed on front of the left sleeve and the left rear sleeve and lower left rear side of the garment. Serological test results showed human blood to be present in these stains.

Several white, brown and black feline hairs were observed adhering to the top of the frame of this item. 

<u>Item 86 - Substance on left arm:</u> No items were found inside this envelope.

Item 87 - Specks from neck area: Microscopic examination of this item revealed a clear synthetic fiber with several brown specks adhering to its surface.

<u>Item 88 - Hair from right inner thigh:</u> Microscopic examination of this item revealed a white feline hair.

<u>Item 89 - White cotton from left inner thigh:</u> Microscopic examination of this item revealed a white cotton fiber ball.

<u>Item 90 - Hair from right upper thigh:</u> Microscopic examination of this item revealed a brown pubic hair.


<u>Item 91 - Substance on left hip:</u> No items were found inside this envelope.


Item 102 - Knapsack: This item consists of a black "TRAIL MAKER" back pack. No blood was detected on this item.

Human blood was shown to be present in stains found on the stains observed on Item 2, Item 3, Item 5, Item 6, Item 7, Item 8, Item 9, Item 10, Item 11, Item 12, Item 13, Item 14, Item 15, Item 16, Item 17, Item 19, Item 20, Item 21, Item 22, Item 23, Item 24, Item 25, Item 30, Item 31, Item 32, Item 33, Item 34, Item 35, Item 36, Item 37, Item 38, Item 39, Item 40, Item 42, Item 44, Item 45, Item 50, Item 51, Item 52, Item 53, Item 54, Item 55, Item 56, Item 57, Item 58, Item 59, Item 60, Item 61, Item 61, Item 62, Item 63, Item 64, Item 65, Item 66, Item 67, Item 68, Item 69 and Item 70.


No further testing was attempted on the blood stain observed on the black high cut reebok sneakers (<u>Item 1</u>) at this time due to the limited size of the sample.

Brown caucasian head hairs which exhibited the same microscopic characteristics as the hairs from the victim's head hair standard (<u>Item 72</u>) were found in the hair from the fifth stair baseboard (<u>Item 18</u>), the hair from inside the cellar door (<u>Item 43</u>), the hair from right hand atop index finger:(<u>Item 80</u>) and the Hairs on right palm (<u>Item 92</u>). Accordingly, these hairs could have originated from the victim.

A white cotton fiber ball was observed in the sample marked white cotton from left inner thigh (<u>Item 89</u>). This item possessed the same microscopic structure as the white cotton fibers found on the white T-shirt (<u>Item 3</u>) and the the white and blue shorts (<u>Item 25</u>). Accordingly, these fibers could have originated from one of these cootton garments or a garment with the same structure as the two items.
