

Massachusetts State police Crime Lab Chemist Mary Kate McGilvray (MKM) conducted the serology testing on only 21 of the 59 items that tested positive for the presence of blood on them.

MKM switched her results from her lab notes to the Serology Report she submitted on at least one sample, possibly more.

When serology samples are examined and when there are different intensities in the antigens, (That range from 1+ to 4+), MKM considers it a mixture from more than one possible contributor. When the antigens are the same intensity MKM considers the sample from only one contributor.

In MKM's lab notes she finds different antigen intensities for the "A" antigen (3+) and the "B" antigen (4+) in item 44-1 and marks the type as (A,B), meaning a mixture of "A" blood with "B" blood profiles.

But, in MKM's official Serology Report she identifies item 44-1 as having (AB) blood type. The significance with the switching of the results is that Janet Downing had (AB) blood type. One would look at the results simply as coming from Janet Downing. But, if MKM reported the results correctly, the sample could have been contributed by a mixture of Paul Downing Sr., Paul Downing Jr., Ryan Downing, Artie Ortiz and/or someone else.

Eddie's attorney did not have MKM's lab notes at trial. Several years after this case, McGilvray was fired from the Director's position at the State Police Crime Lab.
